

Westport Fishermen's Association (WFA) Scholarship Program

POLICY:

1. WFA will award up to two (2) \$650 merit scholarships awards annually to graduating high school seniors, preferably with a demonstrated interest in river/environmental protection.
2. A relative who has been a WFA member in good standing for the previous three years must sponsor the applicant.
3. The scholarship shall be designated a "merit" scholarship. Academic criteria and community citizenship will be evaluated, not financial need.
4. The scholarship check will be sent to the awardee, upon receipt of the college transcript showing successful completion of the first semester.
5. The scholarship is for one year, although awardees are encouraged to apply for WFA continuing scholarships in subsequent years (up to four year awards available).
6. The winners will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:
 - Academic Record
 - Essay
 - Evidence of interest in and activities with an environmental focus
 - References/recommendations
 - Extracurricular activities
 - Community services activities/Work experience (verification required)
 - In some cases, the WFA scholarship committee may interview applicants
7. A committee of three WFA members shall be appointed annually by the President of WFA to review applications and select award recipients.
8. WFA award announcements will be made by June 1st.

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT

1. Complete and sign the WFA Scholarship Application form.
2. Attach the following:
 - a. An essay you write which addresses WFA's mission "to preserve and protect the Westport River's natural environment" and how your educational objectives and your past and anticipated future activities may further this goal.
 - b. Your high school transcript
 - c. Three (3) character references from individuals who hold responsible community positions and are familiar with your academic, extracurricular or community activities. At least one reference should be from a teacher. Relatives or friends are NOT appropriate. These may be attached or you may ask your references to submit directly to WFA. In either case, it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all materials are received by WFA by the deadline.
 - d. A current photograph suitable for publication
